<b>Physician's order includes size of catheter and balloon and reinsertion orders.</b>	
<b>Medical reason for catheter use is documented.</b>	
<b>Catheter use is addressed on quarterly CATs and care plans.</b>	
<b>Nursing assistant care sheet describes catheter care.</b>	
<b>Catheter and perineal care are given with a.m. and p.m. care.</b>	
<b>Intake and output record is maintained.</b>	
<b>Nurses' notes include urinary assessment.</b>	
<b>Need for continuing catheter use is assessed with each quarterly assessment and as needed.</b>	
<b>Urinary analysis is performed as ordered.</b>	
<b>A closed, sterile system with tubing free of kinks is maintained.</b>	
<b>Catheter tubing is secured to prevent catheter being pulled out.</b>	
<b>Catheter tubing is placed below level of bladder.</b>	
<b>Catheter bag covers are used to protect resident's dignity.</b>
